Dear Parents/Guardians:

St. John's, in conjunction with Pius, has contracted a third party service to help with the assessment and recommendation of financial aid for families. FACTS Grant & Aid Assessment will be conducting the financial need analysis for St. John's School for the upcoming 2008-09 school year. Families applying for financial aid will need to complete an application and submit the necessary supporting documentation to FACTS Grant & Aid Assessment by August 15, 2008 for the coming school year. We encourage applicants to apply online at www.factstuitionaid.com. If you do not have internet access at home we will make arrangements for the use of the computers at school. Paper applications will be available in the school office on July 2, 2008. If you have a student at Pius you only need to fill out the FACTS information for Pius. The information will be shared with St. John's for granting tuition assistance at both schools. The following information is required in order for FACTS to process your application:

1. Signed and completed paper application or completed online application.
2. Payment of the \$20 application fee.
3. Copies of your 2006 or 2007 tax forms including all supporting tax schedules.
4. Copies of your 2007 W-2 form for both you and your spouse.
5. Copies of supporting documentation for Social Security Income, Welfare, Child Support, Food Stamps, Workers' Compensation, and TANF.

Those families that have already submitted a tuition assistance application for St. John's back in April, we still want you to complete the FACTS Application. Those that have submitted an application in April will receive financial aid. The amount will be determined by the FACTS Application.
